Locked compartments or otherwise inaccessible areas would also preclude inspection. The Owner is advised to open up all such areas for further inspection as deemed necessary. Further, no determination of stability characteristics or inherent structural integrity will be made and no opinion will be expressed with respect thereto. The survey report will represent the condition of the vessel on the date of the survey is performed, and is the unbiased opinion of the undersigned, but it is not to be considered an inventory or a warranty either specified or implied.
